Your child received his/her first progress report for the year today. Please take a few minutes to review this with your child and consider the following:

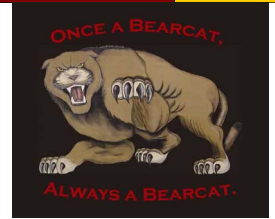
- Give praise for good grades and grades that have improved.
